

Moonlight Sail on White Bear Lake



It's the best time to sail ever...and the most romantic! Sail White Bear Lake on a Catalina 250 leaving the dock just before sundown. Sail for several hours before returning for cocktails at the marina. Wine and cheese provided. Bring a date or (if you're really daring, feel free to date the Captain!).

We will schedule a mostly cloudless night with the moon between first and last quarter, meaning we will have moonlight to sail by. Also we will wait for a night that the wind is forecast to stay up. Normally the wind dies at sundown. So be prepared for only a 1-2 day notice.

If you've not sailed by moonlight, it's a real treat. Sometimes other sailors have the same idea and we may chase a couple of other boats around the lake just for fun. Feel free to have the helm all night, work the foredeck or just kick back and ride along. It's your call.
